Key Financial Points

- 2022-2023 Fees were subsidized by post-Covid recovery grants
- Grants received in 2022 but spent in 2023
- Club is in good financial standing projecting to have 3 months worth of expenses remaining end of June 2024
- Pool costs have increased more pool time compared to 2022
- Wages & payroll have increased (min wage increase)
- Return to full competitions resulted in increased travel and coach costs and competition fees increased
